

ODCMG Facility Rental Prices

- To make a rental reservation, complete the “Facility Rental Application”
- A rental reservation is not complete unless a down payment and signed rental agreement have been received at the ODCMG office
- A renter may be required to provide proof of insurance and/or a security deposit
- Full payment is due by the day of the scheduled rental

Down payment is equal to half of the total rental contract

- Available for rental year round
- 60' x 32' lighted pavilion with an additional enclosed 32'x 20' section on the North end
- Enclosed room with two 6 foot doors to open to the area under the pavilion
- 2 Restrooms
- Includes fourteen 12-foot picnic tables, eight 6-foot picnic tables, lighting and hot and cold water
- Immediate access to the wildlife enclosure viewing platform, Children's play area, and the trail system
- Indoor tables and chairs available
- Air conditioned and heated indoor space
- Loading and unloading area available adjacent to the pavilion
- Gas fire pit (not for cooking) with circle seating (available upon request)
- Access to multiple electrical outlets
- Dumpsters available for event use at no extra cost
- Audio-visual technology available for additional fee

Down Payment is equal to half of the total rental contract

- Available for rental after normal business hours
- 1500 ft² heated/air conditioned education building
- Ideal for groups up to 30 guests
- 2 restrooms
- Includes restrooms, indoor tables and chairs, white board (projector upon request)
- Taxidermy collection and live animals (reptiles, amphibians, birds)
- Air conditioned and heated indoor space
- Dumpsters available for event use at no extra cost
- Audio-visual technology available for additional fee

Activity	Audience	Duration	Description
Catching Critters	All ages	1-2 hours	Sample a wetland or pond with a naturalist using nets, magnifying glasses and collection tubs.
Michigan Wildlife	All ages	1-2 hours	Explore the world of wild animals including reptiles, amphibians, birds and mammals using live animals, taxidermy and animal artifacts.
Eastern Woodland Life	Elementary age and up	1-2 hours	With a focus on the Tribes of the Three Fires, learn about life during the late Woodland Era using a reconstructed Neshnabe village, artifacts and tools.
Snowshoeing	8 yrs old and up	1-2 hours	Hike with a naturalist on Ojibwa-style snowshoes in search of winter wildlife while learning about winter ecology. (must be a minimum of 4 inches of snow on the ground to use snowshoes)

Activity	Audience	Duration	Description
Birds of Prey	All ages	1 hour indoor or 2-4 hours outdoor	Explore the world of birds of prey using our live bird collection, taxidermy and bird artifacts.
Fishing	All ages	2-4 hours	Go fishing at one of our catch and release ponds. Fishing poles, tackle, and worms are provided.
Archery	10 yrs old and up (under 10 not permitted to shoot)	2-4 hours	Shoot at our archery range using a Genesis compound bow or long bow. Archery instruction will be provided by our certified archery instruction staff.
Kayaking	8 yrs old and up (under 8 must be accompanied by adult)	2-4 hours	Use single and double kayaks to paddle on a pond. Launch from the Van Dam Outdoor Classroom. Kayaks, vests and paddles are included.
