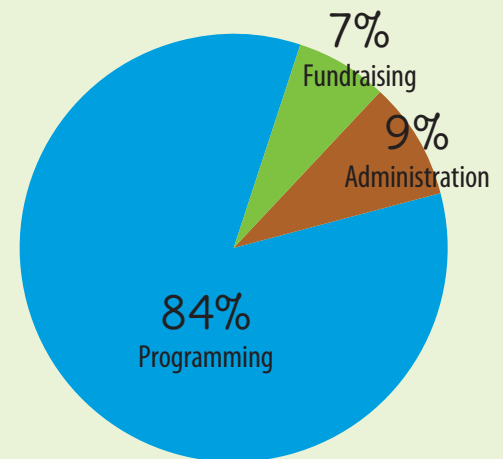
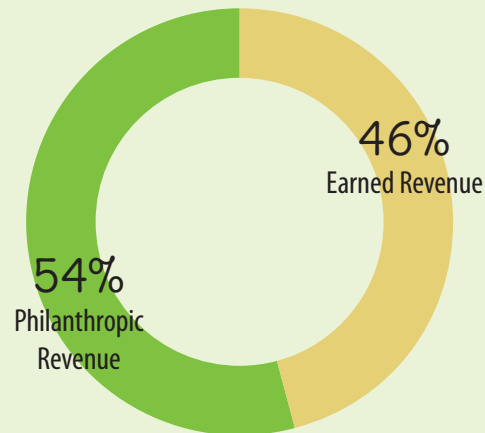
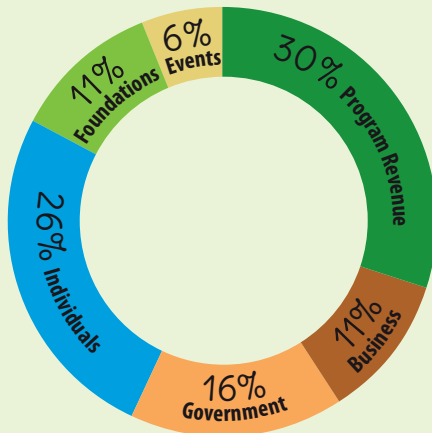
The increase in program participation ODC has seen over the past ten years

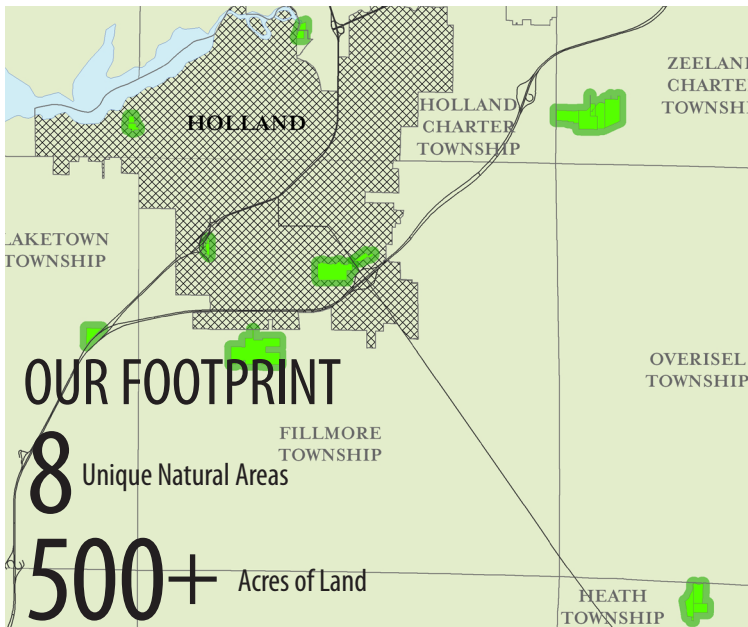
## EDUCATION HIGHLIGHTS over 20 YEARS

- Over 1,250,000 children and families have received an ODC experience
- Over 1,000 programs offered in 2019
- 176 three & four year olds learning in the outdoors at the Little Hawks Discovery Preschool
- 17 ODC Education Network partner schools impacting the lives of 3,500 students
- 10 parenting classes led by Little Hawks social worker with over 400 participants

## CONSERVATION HIGHLIGHTS over 20 YEARS

- Continued development on 2 Greenway Projects covering over 180,000 acres
- Over 100 conservation contracts to manage land
- Established over 20 miles of trail and protected nearly 1,400 acres along the Macatawa Greenway
- Over 30,000 acres of farmland utilizing best management practices
- Substantially improved water quality (lowest phosphorus levels in 47 years)

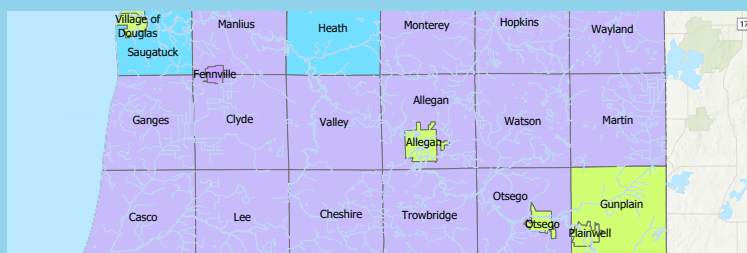
