



BUILD A TIPPY TAP

SUPPLIES:

Water Container [Milk Jug with a Handle Works Best]

String or Rope

Scissors

Hole Punch [or something sharp to poke holes in your water container]

Basin or Bucket to catch water beneath your tippy-tap

Support Poles [Chip is using a chair, you can collect branches, or hang this from a tree, get creative!]

[Clean] Water

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut Support Strings.
2. Tie your string to an edge [usually the handle] of your water container. This piece of string should be long enough to secure your container to your support poles or structure.
3. Hang your container between your support posts.
4. Cut another string that is long enough to hang from your container down to the ground.
5. Tie that string around the mouth of your container. Pulling on this string with your foot [or a partner can pull this string for you] should tip the container down to pour water out.
6. Poke a couple of holes in your container a couple inches below the opening.
7. Full your container with a few cups of water.
8. Pull down on the string to release the flow of water to clean your hands!
