Overview: The ODC Education Network provides education, training, and support to local school districts in order to implement high quality nature based education programs. The ODC Network (ODCN) is a nonprofit organization focused on educating children and families about our natural resources, providing educational programming throughout West Michigan. The summer learning program is a camp-like education setting where informal and formal learning experiences are driven through exploration in nature.

Purpose: The Summer Educator will provide a high quality, developmentally appropriate nature-based experience for children ages 4-7 who are enrolled in summer nature based literacy programs with ODCN.

Primary Responsibilities:

Teaching and Evaluating

- Serve as educator for designated sections of program
- Work cooperatively with team to incorporate nature into daily practices
- Facilitate cooperative/interactive approach to planning and teaching within instructional team
- Assure compliance with all relevant governmental rules and regulations
- Be aware of and responsive to best practices within elementary education and literacy
- Collect, analyze, and process data from weekly instruction to drive interventions and support for students

Creating Community

- Ensure that parents are informed and involved in their children's experiences and progress
- Work collaboratively with the ODCN Team
- Help maintain high quality physical facilities and spaces
- Provide adequate and appropriate supervision for children at all times that promotes the safety and well being of child participants.

- Teaching certificate with elementary, early childhood, ZS endorsement, or Degree in Outdoor Education with teaching certificate preferred but not required
- Background/experience in nature-based instruction, outdoor education, or personal interests in outdoor activities preferred
- Experience in place based, hands-on, or informal learning experiences for elementary students preferred
- Experience in STEM for elementary aged children preferred

- Demonstrated interest in elementary children and literacy
- Interest in nature and being outdoors
- Willingness to spend a significant amount of time outdoors each day, in all types of weather
- Demonstrated good character, responsibility and suitability to meet the needs of children
- Demonstrated ability to work in a team

- Must pass complete background check, including fingerprinting

Physical Demands:

This position requires the following physical activities: pushing, pulling, climbing, walking, standing, squatting, stooping, kneeling, twisting, reaching, sitting, lifting, bending, finger dexterity, grasping, repetitive motions, talking, hearing and visual acuity. The work/teaching is performed indoors and outdoors in most weather conditions.
