Guatemala Billfishing

February 9-13, 2023

5 Days – 4 Nights



The waters of Guatemala are unusually calm year around and are productive for fishing mahi-mahi, sailfish and marlin from 1 mile to 50 miles out. The experienced boat captains and crew have a fleet of luxury class boats, ranging from 32' to 40'. Past trips have averaged anywhere from 8 – 20 sailfish releases per day per boat, along with high potential for marlin, mahi mahi, and tuna. You too can have this adventure!

We have again reserved the services of Pacific Fins Resort and Marina to deliver a top-notch experience. Pacific Fins is really the only true luxury fishing resort in Guatemala. Their boutique hotel with private villas provides an all-inclusive experience for the duration of your trip. Even though they are aware you are there to fish, they also focus their attention to the quality of service offered by English-speaking staff; the comfort and style of Villas and Suites; the gourmet cuisine prepared by local Chefs; and the overall ambiance of the Resort created for your enjoyment.



If you have a significant other that wants to join you but does not want to fish – no problem! Pacific Fins Resort is a great place to just relax by the pool. The weather in Guatemala is warm and sunny. With staff at the resort waiting to assist, you may stay back and enjoy food, drinks, and sunshine. There are also options for a tour of the area and shopping at the local market.

Villas

We will wake up early and travel back to the airport for our departure home. (B)



Trip Cost: \$3,600 per person + flight

Payment: \$1,000 deposit due at time of booking and required to hold a place on the trip; deposit plus \$1,300 1st payment due by June 30, 2022; Final payment of \$1,300 due by October 1, 2022. All payments may be made at one time if desired.

Flights: We will help arrange your flight. All participants need to arrive at the same time. Do not book a flight without discussing it with your trip leader.

Cancellations: No refunds will be given for cancellation of a reservation. If the trip is cancelled due to COVID-19 related issues we will be allowed to reschedule the trip. If the trip is delayed or otherwise post-poned due to weather or other circumstances not in the ODC Explorer Network's control, we will do all we can to reschedule or attempt to get refunded. We do recommend Travel Insurance to fully protect your investment.

Included: all lodging, daily laundry service, food, all drinks, ground transportation in Guatemala, fishing, and all gratuities while in Guatemala.

Not included: Flight to and from La Aurora International Airport in Guatemala City. Before purchasing flights, please contact Travis Williams to make sure your flights align with the group's plans. Travis may arrange your air travel for you with the help of Travel Leaders in Jenison.
