Core to Our Values

The ODC Network (ODCN) strives to incorporate sustainability as one of its core organizational values. It is a means of connecting the two foundational pursuits of our mission; a tangible way to act on the outdoor education that we provide in a manner that promotes conservation of the land, water, and natural resources. We acknowledge the importance of stewarding the land, as the indigenous peoples did long before us, for the betterment of the entire community.

Towards a Nature-rich Community

We affirm the common definition of sustainability as "meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs." - Collaborating with community partners to advance sustainability
