

1) Your Website

One of the most effective ways you can help spread the word about the Macatawa Water Festival is by providing an easily found link to the event on your website.

As a main information hub, your website allows potential attendees to simply click and be taken directly to the event page—without any hassle or steps in between.

Putting a highly visible website link on your site also makes it easier to direct people to the event page.

When you're sharing information, it's generally best to say, "If you go to the main page of our site, the link to the Macatawa Water Festival is right there," as opposed to sharing an unfamiliar URL.
