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RECEIPT OF BIDS

BID HOLD PERIOD

Bids shall remain subject to acceptance for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening.

OBTAIN BID DOCUMENTS

Bid Documents will be available beginning at 1 p.m. Tuesday, July 1, 2025. Bid Documents will be available electronically, free of charge, via OneDrive. Alternate means of distribution are available upon request. Hardcopies of the documents will not be provided.

Bid Documents consist of the Proposal and Specifications; Drawings; and any Addenda.

PROJECT LOCATION

The Macatawa River is located in Section 26, Township 5 North, Range 15 West in the City of Holland, Ottawa County, Michigan. The Project begins at the pedestrian bridge upstream of the confluence with Noordeloos Creek in Paw Paw Park and extends approximately 1,000 linear feet upstream.

BACKGROUND

A portion of the Macatawa River upstream of the confluence with Noordeloos Creek has steep highly eroding banks that are major source of sediment and phosphorous to the Macatawa River and Lake Macatawa. The purpose of the project is to reduce erosion, expand awareness of more sustainable restoration techniques, and result in higher quality habitat.

The project reach is a portion of the Macatawa River Intercounty Drain.

PROJECT

The Project generally consists of the following Work: Excavation of existing streambanks for the construction of flood benches; stone in-stream structures.
