Day 1

Arrival in Seattle

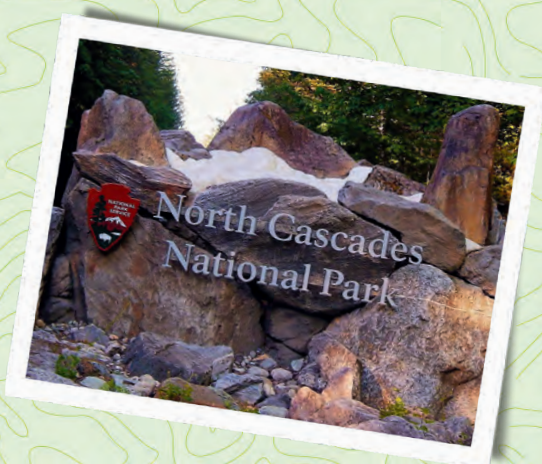
Arrive in Seattle and begin your Pacific Northwest adventure at the Saltwater State Park to explore scenic shoreline trails, forested paths, and the beautiful waters of Puget Sound.



Day 2-4

North Cascades National Park

Journey into the spectacular wilderness of North Cascades National Park, where rugged peaks, glaciers, and turquoise lakes create some of the most dramatic scenery in the Pacific Northwest. Visit Diablo Dam and take in stunning views of Diablo Lake before exploring renowned trails in the area. Optional adventures may include a big canoe trip on Diablo Lake, offering a unique perspective on this breathtaking mountain landscape.





Day 5-7

San Juan Islands

Travel by ferry to San Juan Island and settle into the beautiful Roche Harbor Resort. Enjoy orcas up close on a whale-watching tour, discover marine life through tide pooling, and experience the wonder of bioluminescence by kayaking after dark. Additional island adventures may include exploring scenic shorelines and forests, browsing charming waterfront communities, and enjoying the unique beauty and culture of the island. We will get an amazing peek at a large variety of wildlife that may include seals, sea lions, foxes, otters, and so much more.



Day 8

After an amazing week in the Pacific Northwest, spend your last morning in Seattle before returning home.
